



In case of a fire in your vehicle



Take the following steps:



Stop the vehicle and park it by the roadside or in a safe place to avoid blocking traffic.



Stop the engine, leave the vehicle immediately and take along a fire extinguisher if you have one.



Call the Civil Defence on 999.



If the fire is limited to the engine, you can start fighting the flames from the bonnet, as most such fires are caused by a short circuit. Don't lift the bonnet so as to avoid burns to yourself and to avert the possibility of the fire spreading.



For your safety, inspect your vehicle periodically.
